

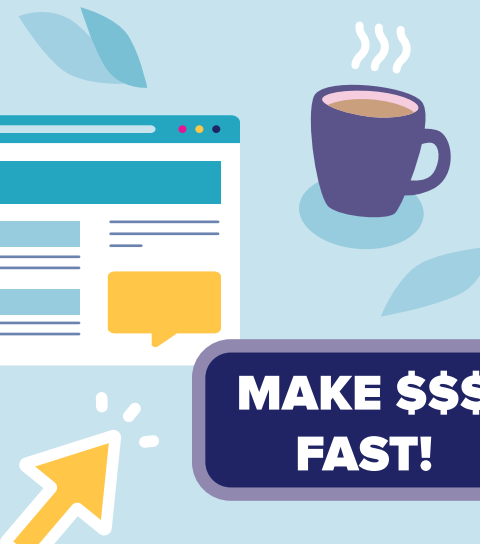

Don't pay for
the promise
of a job.



Remember...

Scammers advertise jobs the same way honest employers do

Scammers place ads on job websites, social media, TV, radio, and in newspapers. But what they want is your money or personal information.

Don't pay for a promise

Scammers might guarantee you a job — if you pay a fee. But honest employers will never ask you to pay to get a job.

Never bank on a “cleared” check

Only scammers will send you a check and tell you to send on part of the money, or buy gift cards with it. The check will bounce and the bank will want you to repay the money.
